AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE NAMING OF THE JOSEPH O'LOUGHLIN POND .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court
assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE NAMING OF THE JOSEPH O'LOUGHLIN POND

- 1 SECTION 1. *The pond, located at Gate 31 in the Quabbin Reservoir, also known as the Robert D. Wetmore Fishing*
- 2 *Area, in the town of New Salem shall be designated and known as the Joseph P. O'Loughlin Pond, in memory of*
- 3 *Joseph P. O'Loughlin, a former dedicated employee of the department of conservation and recreation in the town of*
- 4 *New Salem. The department of conservation and recreation shall erect and maintain a suitable marker bearing that*
- 5 *designation in compliance with the standards of said department.*
