## AN ACT RELATIVE TO FLOOD STORAGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Boston
- 2 Metropolitan Area Planning Council shall conduct a study of potential flood storage locations
- 3 and water quality improvements in the Alewife Brook watershed in the Cities of Cambridge and
- 4 Somerville, and in the Towns of Arlington and Belmont.
  
- 5 Within one hundred and eighty (180) days of passage of this act, the Boston Metropolitan Area
- 6 Planning Council shall submit a report to the clerks of the House and Senate detailing a plan
- 7 concerning the implementation of said study.
  
- 8 SECTION 2: A sum of \$100,000 shall be appropriate for the purpose of funding the study
- 9 required by SECTION 1."
