**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act amending victim compensation statute.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2(e) of chapter 258C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the word “shall” and inserting in place thereof
3 the word “may.”

4 SECTION 2. Said section 2(e), as so appearing, is further amended by inserting after the
5 second sentence thereof the following sentence:-

6 In the event of a victim’s death by homicide, said award may be reduced except the costs
7 for appropriate and modest funeral, burial, and/or cremation services shall be paid by the fund.
