Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1: The first paragraph of section 19 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 on the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second sentence the
- 3 following sentence:-
- 4 "The exemption from income taxes leveled under chapter 62 shall be applicable to the first
- 5 \$50,000 annually".
- 6 SECTION 2: This act shall take effect upon passage.
