An Act relative to mooring fee requirements.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 33 of Chapter 291 of the Acts of 2004 is hereby repealed.

2 SECTION 2. Section 10A of Chapter 91 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
3 official edition, is hereby amended by striking out in lines 10 through 12 the words “but no
4 mooring fee shall discriminate on the basis of residence;”.
