An Act relative to court filing fees for noncriminal offenses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Paragraph (4) of subsection (A) of section 3 of Chapter 90C of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition is hereby amended by striking out, in line 36,  
3 “together with a \$25 court filing fee”.

4           SECTION 2. Said paragraph of subsection (A) of section 3 of Chapter 90C, as so  
5 appearing, is hereby further amended by striking out lines 38 to 47

6           SECTION 3. This act shall take effect 90 days after its passage
