RESOLVE Resolve providing for an investigation and study by a special commission relative to the misclassification and misdiagnosis of former residents of the Fernald state school

#### Resolved,

- 1 RESOLVED, That a special commission, to consist of 3 members of the senate, 3
- 2 members of the house of representatives, the commissioner of mental retardation or his designee
- 3 and 4 members to be appointed by the governor, 1 of whom shall be a member of the Fernald
- 4 League is hereby establish for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative to the
- 5 misclassification and misdiagnosis of former residents of the Fernald State School. Said
- 6 investigation and study shall include, but not be limited to the extent and effect of such
- 7 misclassifications, reparations for the denial of education and labor performed and the providing
- 8 of counseling for former residents.
- 9 Said commission shall report to the house of representatives the results of its investigation and
- 10 study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its
- 11 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on
- 12 or before Jan 1,2011.
