Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 13 of chapter 21A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

- 4 □For the purposes of this section, a watershed of a coastal estuary or embayment that is included
- 5 in the Massachusetts integrated list of waters, that is identified as impaired, due in whole or in
- 6 part to nitrogen pollution, shall be deemed to be a nitrogen sensitive area. The department of
- 7 environmental protection shall promulgate such rules and regulations as it considers necessary to
- 8 fulfill the requirements of this section.
