In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to insurance vehicle surcharges.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:- Any person the

3 commissioner deems to be an involved operator, either because the person is determined to have

4 been operating a motor vehicle at the time of an accident or because the person has a traffic law

5 violation, and who has 2 or more motor vehicles registered in his or her name, shall only be

6 subject to an operator surcharge on the motor vehicle involved in the accident or traffic law

7 violation and shall not be subject to the same surcharge on any other vehicle.
