An Act relative to motor vehicle insurance charges.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 113 B of Chapter 175 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2012 official edition, is hereby amended by placing therein the following.-

3 There shall be no surcharge incurred by an insured motorist if they have had only one  
4 incident subject to a surcharge, defined herein, within any four year period.
