In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to physical therapy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the 2 following new section:-

3 Section 226. Physical Therapy Copayments

4 (a) An insurer shall not impose a copayment, coinsurance, or office visit deductible

5 amount charged to the insured for services rendered for each date of service by a physical

6 therapist licensed under section 23B of chapter 112 that is greater than the copayment,

7 coinsurance, or office visit deductible amount charged to the insured for the services of a primary

8 care physician or an osteopath licensed under section 2 of Chapter 112 for an office visit.

9 (b) An insurer shall state clearly the availability of physical therapy coverage under its 10 plan and all related limitations, conditions, and exclusions.
