In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to solid waste disposal facilities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 150A of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the 18th paragraph the following
 paragraph: Nothing in this section shall be deemed to prevent or restrict a city or town from enacting

or enforcing zoning ordinance or by laws pursuant to chapter 40A or any other authorizing
statutes which ordinances or by-laws are applicable to landfills, transfer stations, recycling
centers and sanitary waste disposal sites provided that such ordinances or by-laws do not prevent
closure activities, maintenance activities or assessment activities which are necessary to protect
the public health, public safety or the environment as determined by the department based on
substantial evidence.
