**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to applied behavior analysis services.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 118E is hereby amended by adding after section 10J the following
2 section:-

3 Section 10K. The division shall provide coverage for applied behavior analysis treatment
4 for individuals 21 years of age and older who are receiving medical coverage under this chapter
5 and who are diagnosed with an intellectual disability as defined in Section 1 of Chapter 123B or
6 a developmental disability, as defined in Section 1 of Chapter 123B. This treatment shall be
7 covered when prescribed as medically necessary by a licensed physician and with clinical
8 direction by a licensed applied behavior analyst.
