In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act protecting children.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 269 of the General Laws be amended by adding the following new section:
- 3 Section 20: Whoever, being the parent, legal guardian, or caretaker of a minor child,
- 4 and who has knowledge of the death of said minor child, and who fails to notify law enforcement
- 5 or emergency medical personnel of the death of said minor child, within twenty-four hours of
- 6 death, shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for not more than five years or by a
- 7 fine of not more than ten thousand dollars and imprisonment in jail or a house of correction for
- 8 not more than two and one half years.
