In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act to provide for tobacco cessation benefits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 32A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 17K the following section:-

- 4 Section 17L. The commission shall provide to any active or retired employee of the
- 5 commonwealth who is insured under the group insurance commission a smoking and tobacco
- 6 use cessation treatment benefit. Smoking and tobacco use cessation treatment and information
- 7 benefits shall include nicotine replacement therapy, other evidence-based pharmacologic aids to
- 8 quitting smoking, and accompanying counseling by a physician, certified tobacco use cessation
- 9 counselor, or other qualified clinician.
