*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 5, subsection (e) of Chapter 161A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 official edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end the following sentence: “Further, the
- 3 board shall not require payment of any fare by any person 80 years of age or older.”
