**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to legal holidays.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 13 of chapter 136 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 5, the following words:- , May
3 twentieth.

4 SECTION 2. Said section 13 of said chapter 136, as so appearing, is hereby further
5 amended by striking out, in lines 5 and 6, the following words:- after the hour of twelve noon.

6 SECTION 3. Said section 13 of said chapter 136, as so appearing, is hereby further
7 amended by striking out, in line 6 and 7, the following words:- after one o'clock post meridian.
