### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to inspections for new automobiles..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION . Section 7A of Chapter 90, of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 official
- 2 edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the fifth paragraph the following paragraph:-
- 3 "The emissions and maintenance inspection programs provided for in this article shall not apply
- 4 to any in the year of its manufacture, nor the year succeeding its manufacture year. The
- 5 commissioner shall promulgate such regulations as may be required to implement this
- 6 exemption."
