### AN ACT RELATIVE TO INSURANCE SURCHARGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, section 113B of chapter 175 of
- 2 the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 221,
- 3 after the word “incident.”, the following sentence:- “Driving a motor vehicle that has an expired
- 4 inspection sticker shall not be considered a surchargeable incident.”
