An Act relative to accessibility at gas station.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the Office on Disability is hereby directed and authorized to conduct a comprehensive study to investigate accessibility to gas pumps at gas stations. Said study shall include, but not be

- 4 limited to, compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act's assistance at self-service gas
- 5 station guidelines. The Office on Disability shall provide an opportunity for interested parties to
- 6 submit relevant testimony. The Office on Disability shall file a report of its study, including
- 7 recommendations and drafts of any legislation, if necessary, with the clerks of the Senate and
- 8 House of Representatives within one year of the effective date of this act.
