# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to insurance coverage for PANDAS/PANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 32A of the General Laws, as amended by Chapter 403 of the Acts
2	of 2012, is hereby amended by inserting after section 17K the following section:-
3	Section 17L. The commission shall provide to any active or retired employee of the
4	commonwealth who is insured under the group insurance commission, coverage for treatment of
5	pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and
6	pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome. Said treatment shall include, but not be limited
7	to, the use of Intravenous immunoglobulin (IVIG) therapy.
8	SECTION 2. Chapter 175 of the General Laws, as amended by Chapter 403 of the Acts

9 of 2012, is hereby amended by inserting after section 47DD the following section:-

10 Section 47EE. Any policy, contract, agreement, plan or certificate of insurance issued, 11 delivered or renewed within the commonwealth shall provide coverage for treatment of pediatric 12 autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric 13 acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome. Said treatment shall include, but not be limited to, the 14 use of Intravenous immunoglobulin (IVIG) therapy.

15 SECTION 3. Chapter 176A of the General Laws, as amended by Chapter 403 of the Acts
16 of 2012, is hereby amended by inserting after section 8EE the following section:-

17 Section 8FF. Any contract between a subscriber and a corporation under an individual or 18 group hospital service plan delivered, issued or renewed within the commonwealth shall provide 19 coverage for treatment of pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with 20 streptococcal infections and pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome. Said treatment 21 shall include, but not be limited to, the use of Intravenous immunoglobulin (IVIG) therapy.

SECTION 4. Chapter 176B of the General Laws, as amended by Chapter 403 of the Acts
 of 2012, is hereby amended by inserting after section 4FF the following section:-

Section 4GG. Any subscription certificate under an individual or group medical service agreement delivered, issued or renewed within the commonwealth shall provide coverage for treatment of pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome. Said treatment shall include, but not be limited to, the use of Intravenous immunoglobulin (IVIG) therapy.

29 SECTION 5. Chapter 176G of the General Laws, as amended by Chapter 403 of the Acts
30 of 2012, is hereby amended by inserting after section 4X the following section:-

31 Section 4Y. Any individual or group health maintenance contract shall provide coverage 32 for treatment of pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal 33 infections and pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome. Said treatment shall include, but 34 not be limited to, the use of Intravenous immunoglobulin (IVIG) therapy.
