**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**

An Act relative to encouraging volunteerism for non-profit organizations providing transportation options for seniors .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. General Laws Chapter 175, Section 113B, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding after the fifth paragraph the following paragraph:

3 In fixing and establishing classifications of risks, the commissioner shall not group risks  
4 attributable to transportation by any volunteer driver otherwise licensed in accordance with the  
5 provisions of Chapter 90 of the General Laws who is providing such volunteer services at the  
6 direction of a charitable organization organized pursuant to General Laws Chapter 180 where a  
7 primay purpose of such charitable organization is the transportation of individuals over the age  
8 of sixty or individuals with disabilities.
