## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act requiring liability insurance for landscapers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after section 111H the following section:-
- 3 Section 111I. A landscaper engaged in the practice of landscaping commercial or
- 4 residential property shall secure, maintain and file with the division of insurance satisfactory
- 5 proof of a certificate of a liability insurance policy which shall be in a minimum amount of
- 6 \$250,000 in the aggregate. Every liability insurance policy shall stipulate that cancellation or
- 7 nonrenewal of the policy shall not be effective until at least 10 days' notice of intention to cancel
- 8 or not renew has been received in writing by the division of insurance.
- A landscaper shall not perform landscaping on any commercial or residential property
- unless such work is covered by a liability insurance policy of at least \$250,000 in the aggregate.
- 11 Such proof shall be deemed satisfactory as the policies carried by the company, partnership or
- 12 franchise for which the landscaper is a contract employee and that the landscaper is specifically

- 13 covered by such policy. For the purposes of this section the term "landscaper" shall mean any 14 person engaged in the full-time business of installing or maintaining the landscape of any
- 15 commercial or residential property.
- The commissioner of insurance shall adopt rules and regulations designed to ensure the
- 17 availability of liability insurance for landscapers as required by this section.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2020.
