*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding and general or special law to the contrary, the Division of
- 2 Personnel Administration is required to conduct a Civil Service Exam for employees holding the
- 3 title of Benefits Eligibility and Referral Social Worker A/B and C no later than one year after
- 4 this law goes into effect.
