Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 32A of the General Laws, as amended by Chapter 403 of the Acts
2	of 2012, is hereby amended by inserting after section 17K the following section:-

4	□ Section 17L. The commission shall provide to any active or retired employee of the
5	commonwealth who is insured under the group insurance commission, coverage for treatment of
6	pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and
7	pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome. Said treatment shall include, but not be limited
8	to, the use of Intravenous immunoglobulin (IVIG) therapy.

10	□ SECTION 2. Chapter 175 of the General Laws, as amended by Chapter 403 of the Acts of
11	2012, is hereby amended by inserting after section 47DD the following section:-

13	☐ Section 47EE. Any policy, contract, agreement, plan or certificate of insurance issued,
14	delivered or renewed within the commonwealth shall provide coverage for treatment of pediatric
15	autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric
16	acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome. Said treatment shall include, but not be limited to, the
17	use of Intravenous immunoglobulin (IVIG) therapy.

24	coverage for treatment of pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with
25	streptococcal infections and pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome. Said treatment
26	shall include, but not be limited to, the use of Intravenous immunoglobulin (IVIG) therapy.

34	infections and pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome. Said treatment shall include, but
35	not be limited to, the use of Intravenous immunoglobulin (IVIG) therapy.
