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**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**  
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An Act expanding the interscholastic athletic head injury safety training program to include private schools.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           The first paragraph of subsection (a) of section 222 of chapter 111 of the General Laws is
- 2 amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:-
- 3 The department shall direct the division of violence and injury prevention to develop an
- 4 interscholastic athletic head injury safety training program in which all schools, including
- 5 schools subject to the Massachusetts Interscholastic Athletic Association and the New England
- 6 Preparatory School Athletic Council rules, shall participate.
