An Act prohibiting the obstruction of state highways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the
- 2 following section:-
- 3 Section 106. Whoever commits or attempts to commit any act to obstruct, block, detain,
- 4 or render passage impossible, unsafe or unreasonably difficult for the normal movement of
- 5 traffic, commerce, or any emergency medical services on a limited access or express state
- 6 highway in any manner that is dangerous to the general public, shall be punished by
- 7 imprisonment in a state prison for not more than 10 years.
