In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to municipalities' liability for post-employment benefits other than pensions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Each city and town shall report to the Division of Local Services its liability for post-
- 2 employment benefits other than pensions provided to retired employees, including but not
- 3 limited to health insurance and dental and vision benefits. The Division shall provide the data to
- 4 the House and Senate Committees on Ways and Means and to the Executive Office for
- 5 Administration and Finance not later than July 1, 2012.
