#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act to further define medical necessity determinations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1: Section 8a of Chapter 118E is amended by inserting the following new
- 2 sentence at the end of the definition "Medically Necessary Services" the following new sentence:
- 3 "Medical necessary services for mental health treatment shall be determined by the treating
- 4 clinician in consultation with the patient and noted in the patient's medical record".
- 5 SECTION 2: Section 16 (b) of Chapter 1760 is amended by inserting the following new
- 6 sentence at the end after the word "restriction" the following new sentence. "Medical necessity
- 7 for mental health services shall be determined by the treating clinician in consultation with the
- 8 patient and noted in the patient's medical record."
