## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act enhancing data transparency within the prosecutorial system.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Section 10 of chapter 69 of the acts of 2018 is hereby amended by striking out the sixth

2 paragraph, beginning with the number "(15)", and inserting in place thereof the following new

3 paragraphs:-

4 (15) Subsequent to data collection and reporting standards established in paragraphs 12,

5 13 and 14, an additional subset of data collection and reporting standards shall be established and

6 developed for district attorney offices, criminal justice agencies of the commonwealth.

7 (16) The data collection and reporting standards established in paragraphs 12, 13, 14 and

8 15 shall be developed in consultation with the executive office of technology services and

9 security.
