An Act relative to cueing and supervision in the PCA program.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 12 of chapter 118E of the General Laws is hereby amended in the first paragraph  
2 by inserting at the end thereof the following new sentence:-

3           Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the division  
4 shall develop or amend any standards and regulations applicable to the personal care attendant  
5 program to include as eligible members those individuals who are otherwise eligible for said  
6 program, but who require supervision and cueing in order to perform two or more activities of  
7 daily living.
