In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act maintaining protective orders.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3 of chapter 209A, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended
- 2 by striking subsection (h) and inserting in place thereof the following subsection:-
- 3 (h) ordering the defendant to refrain from abusing or contacting the plaintiff's child, or
- 4 child in plaintiff's care or custody, unless authorized by the court, which shall survive the death
- of the plaintiff until such orders are vacated by the court or until the orders expires;
