An Act relative to energy efficient marijuana cultivation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the secretary of  
2 energy and environmental affairs, in consultation with the commissioner of energy resources, the  
3 commissioner of environmental protection and the commissioner of agricultural resources, shall  
4 make recommendations for energy and water use efficiency for licensed marijuana cultivators in  
5 the commonwealth.

6           The secretary shall file the recommendations as a report with the house and senate chairs  
7 of the joint committee on telecommunications, utilities and energy, the house and senate chairs  
8 of the joint committee on marijuana and the clerks of the house of representatives and the senate  
9 by January 15, 2018. The cannabis control commission shall promulgate regulations based on  
10 these recommendations.
