An Act relative to the practice of psychiatry.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph:-

3 Any physician licensed pursuant to this section who specializes in the practice of

4 psychiatry shall, as a condition of granting or renewing the psychiatrist's certificate of

5 registration, apply to participate in the medical assistance program administered by the secretary

6 of health and human services in accordance with chapter 118E and Title XIX of the Social

7 Security Act and any federal demonstration or waiver relating to such medical assistance

8 program. The division may promulgate regulations under said chapter 118E to establish a

9 caseload capacity for each individual, group or facility.
