An Act relative to medical malpractice.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after paragraph 7 the following paragraph:- Notwithstanding any general  
3 or special law to the contrary, if a registered physician is convicted of 3 cases of medical  
4 malpractice the board shall revoke said physician's registration.
