An Act removing the charitable immunity cap.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 85K of Chapter 231 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 official  
2 edition, is hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the  
3 following sentence:-

4           It shall not constitute a defense to any cause of action based on tort brought against a  
5 corporation, trustees of a trust, or members of an association that said corporation, trust, or  
6 association is, or at the time the cause of action arose was, a charity.
