## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act codifying the Hepatitis C program..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after section 40 the following new section:-
- 3 Section 4P. Program to Combat Hepatitis C
- 4 (a) The department shall, subject to appropriation, establish and maintain a program to
- 5 mitigate the impacts of hepatitis C. The program shall provide screening, information, education
- 6 and treatment components, and may include research grants. The program shall increase public
- 7 awareness of hepatitis C and such efforts shall be undertaken in multiple languages and in a
- 8 culturally appropriate manner. The program shall provide information to health care providers
- 9 about risks, available prevention methods, and treatment options for hepatitis C.

- (b) The program, to the extent the department determines feasible and appropriate,
   shall be integrated with substance abuse, HIV/AIDS and sexually transmitted disease service
   programs.
- 13 (c) The department may accept for the purposes of the program any special grant of 14 money, services or property from the federal government or any of its agencies or from any 15 foundation, medical school or other organization.
