## AN ACT RELATIVE TO FLEA MARKET VENDORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The definition of “Transient Vendor” in Section 1 of Chapter 101 of the General  
2 Laws as so appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding after the first  
3 sentence the following:-

4 “The provisions of this chapter will not apply to vendors and promoters in flea markets so  
5 called.”

6 SECTION 2. Section 2 of Chapter 101 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out  
7 the last sentence of this paragraph and inserting the following:-

8 “The provisions of this chapter will not apply to vendors and promoters in flea markets so  
9 called.”
