### AN ACT RELATIVE TO DEFINING EMPLOYEES CLASSIFIED IN GROUP 4.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002 Official Edition,  
2 is further amended by inserting in section 3(g), in line 293, after the word "supervisor", the  
3 following new words:— associate probation officers, probation officer, assistant chief probation  
4 officer, probation officer-in-charge and day reporting center probation officer, first assistant  
5 chief probation officer, court officer 1, court officer II, assistant and chief court officer, associate  
6 court officer and court officer- in-charge.
