An Act relative to equal access to original birth certificates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 2B of chapter 46 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 3, the words “on or before July 17, 1974 or on or after
3 January 1, 2008” and by striking out in lines 4 and 5, the words “on or after January 1, 2008.”
