Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 13 of Chapter 258C is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the
- 2 following:- No person who, in good faith, during a declared public health emergency donates
- 3 food or other items shall be liable in a civil suit for damages as a result of any acts or omissions
- 4 in providing or obtaining, or attempting to provide or obtain, such assistance unless such acts or
- 5 omissions constitute willful, wanton or reckless conduct.
