#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to respiratory therapy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 23V of Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 adding the following at the end thereof:-
- 3 "(e) Any employee working for a Massachusetts durable medical equipment company
- 4 and having a minimum of 500 hours of positive airway pressure equipment and supply related
- 5 training under the supervision of a Massachusetts licensed Respiratory Therapist may perform
- 6 the delivery, set-up and maintenance of positive airway pressure equipment and supplies for
- 7 home care patients with a diagnosis of obstructive sleep apnea. This exemption does not apply to
- 8 clinical assessment, clinical evaluation, or clinical intervention on home care patients."
