An Act relative to the inspection of power operated doors..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 3A of chapter 143 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 1994 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:—  
3 In addition to the foregoing, the local inspector shall, at least annually, perform inspections and  
4 safety tests on all power-operated doors within the city or town from which he is appointed.
