Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 3 stadiums based on average attendance, provided that until such time, any stadium associated with
- 4 an institution of secondary education shall be exempt from the definition of "places of assembly"
- 5 pursuant to 248 CMR 10.10 (18) (a) and (b).
