An Act increasing fairness in distribution of local aid generated by the state lottery.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 24 of chapter 10C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word “law”, in line 67, the following words:-  
3           “, including but not limited to: (1) the percentage of total lottery revenue collected from  
4 the municipality; (2) median household income in the municipality; and (3) the financial needs of  
5 local public schools”
