## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 148 of Chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 official
- 2 edition, is hereby amended by striking the fifth paragraph and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following paragraph:-
- 4 This section shall not apply to an employee of a co-operative association if he is a
- 5 shareholder therein, unless he requests such association to pay him weekly, nor to casual
- 6 employees as hereinbefore defined employed by the commonwealth or by any county, city or
- 7 town.
