An Act relative to the Architectural Access Board.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 13A of Chapter 22 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the second and third sentences in the first 3 paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following"- "Two of the appointive members shall 4 be architects licensed to practice in the Commonwealth. One of the appointive members shall be 5 a licensed building inspector. Three of the appointive members shall be selected after 6 consultation with advocacy groups on behalf of persons with disabilities.

Buildings that are open to and used by the public shall include, but not be limited to: transportation terminals, institutional buildings, commercial buildings, buildings having places of assembly, hotels, motels, dormitories, funeral homes, shopping centers, restaurants, public parking garages or lots, public sidewalks and ways, and public and common use areas of
