Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section sixteen of chapter 127 of the general laws, as appearing in the

- 3 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:— During the
- 4 conduct of any such physical examination or any subsequent medical examination of a female
- 5 inmate, the presence of a female nurse or female corrections officer shall be required. Nothing in
- 6 this section shall prohibit the rendering of immediate emergency medical treatment for a
- 7 potentially life-threatening condition.
