Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 110 of Chapter 205 of the Acts of 1996 is hereby amended in the first sentence
2 by deleting the words after “General Edward Lawrence Logan international airport” and
3 inserting in place thereof the following:-
4 “and shall have concurrent police authority with the local police force in all other Massachusetts
5 port authority properties.”
