An Act to inform prescribers of non-opioid alternative care.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 94C Sec 18 (e) of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting at the end  
2 thereof the following: The Boards shall consult with Massachusetts Chiropractic Society during  
3 the process of developing the training programs, in order to insure that those programs include  
4 education for the prescribers that includes accurate information about chiropractic as an  
5 alternative form of care instead of opioids.
